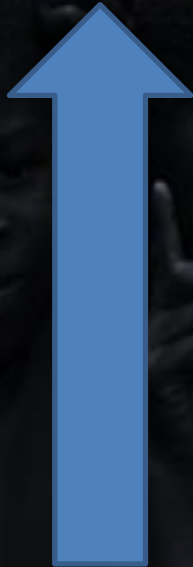

300,000

IN 2015-2016, AT LEAST 300,000 UNACCOMPANIED AND SEPARATED REFUGEE CHILDREN WERE REGISTERED IN 80 COUNTRIES, FIVE TIMES AS MANY AS IN 2010 - 2011.

A: RIGHTS ARE FOR ALL CHILDREN

- **Key idea:** Rights are for all children and young people across the world.
- **Key word:** Universal

B: RIGHTS ARE THERE AT BIRTH

- **Key idea:** Humans are born with rights.
- **Key word:** Inherent

C: RIGHTS CANNOT BE TAKEN AWAY

- **Key idea:** Rights cannot be given, taken away, bought or sold
- **Key word:** Inalienable

D: RIGHTS DO NOT HAVE TO BE EARNED

- **Key idea:** Rights do not come with any conditions attached and are not linked to responsibilities as they are not earned.
- **Key word:** Unconditional

E: ALL RIGHTS ARE EQUALLY IMPORTANT

- **Key idea:** Every right is important in order for children and young people to survive, develop and reach their full potential. Rights are a whole package and are interlinked.
- **Key word:** Indivisible
