Maths



This half term we will be working on addition and subtraction within 10. We will be looking at different ways of drawing and presenting number sentences.

We will continue to count forwards and backwards to 50.

Finally, we will start counting in 10's and 2's.

Science

This half term we will be focusing on trees. We will be looking at identify trees by there leaves. The structure of a tree and we will look at the difference between evergreens and deciduous trees.
