$$75\% = 0.75 = \frac{3}{4} = \frac{75}{100}$$

$$10\% = 0.1 = \frac{1}{10} = \frac{10}{100} = \frac{100}{1000}$$

$$20\% = 0.2 = \frac{1}{5} = \frac{2}{10} = \frac{20}{100}$$

$$50\% = 0.5 = \frac{1}{2} = \frac{5}{10} = \frac{50}{100}$$

$$40\% = 0.4 = \frac{2}{5} = \frac{4}{10} = \frac{40}{100}$$

$$25\% = 0.25 = \frac{1}{4} = \frac{25}{100}$$
