

Religious Education

This term will be learning

Christmas - we will be learning about the Christmas story and how Jesus birth was so different to births today.

Revelation - In this unit the pupils are introduced to stories that show how special Jesus is. They begin to explore, through the story of the Good Samaritan, what God's love is like.

The pupils are also introduced to miracles stories, which show how important Jesus is and to the idea of signs and symbols.



The key scriptures we will study are:

Luke 10: 25-37 – the Good Samaritan Luke 15: 11-32 – the Prodigal Son (Luke 15: 1-7 – the Lost Sheep – covered in EYFS) Matthew 14: 13-21 – Feeding of 5000 Matthew 20: 29-34 – the Healing of the Blind Man

English

In English this term we will be exploring books based on London, including some stories around the Great Fire of London. Children will be continuing to develop their knowledge around sentence structure and punctuation. We will be introducing the use of questions marks and composing questions



Maths

This half term we will be securing place value from 1-75. We will be spending more time on looking at addition and subtraction, with a focus on numbers bonds. We will be looking at the significance of 10 and exploring teen numbers. We will continue to work on counting in both 5's and 10's.



Science

This term we will be looking at everyday materials. The children will distinguish between an object and the material from which it is made. They will identify and name a range of everyday materials, including wood, plastic, glass, metal, water and rock. They will then describe the properties of a range of everyday materials.



Physical Education

The focus of our PE lessons this half term is:

We will be looking at Dance

Humanities

This half term we will be learning all about The Great Fire of London. We will be looking at what happened and how the first started. We will be looking at ordering things in chronological order. We will be comparing how things have changed.

Children will be doing lots of practical activities surrounding this topic.



Creative Arts

In Art this term we will be exploring Van Gogh and looking at ways of using different pencils to shape out work. We will be exploring movement lines and using view finders in our work.



PSHE

During PSHE and RHE we will be looking at; How our feelings can keep us safe - including online safety. Safe and unsafe touches. Medicine safety. Sleep. Feelings, likes and dislikes. These units of work link to the UN right 27 - Food, clothing and living in a safe home.

UN right 34 - protection from abuse.

UN right 12 - Respect for children's views
