## Creative Arts

We explore the composition of a still life (triangle formation) and using the Vanitas concept and the Dutch painters, will form basic geometric shapes with line. We then use varying lines to fill in each blocked shape

Children will also look closely at Caravaggio and 'Supper at Emmaus'. This is the moment where Jesus revealed his true identity. We will study how tone has been used to give emphasis to this drama and focus on the contrast between light and dark. Children will then create our own version of this piece.
