This term will be learning about Lent

Exodus 20: 1 – 17 – Ten Commandments



English

This half term we will be reading:



Our focus this term will be on retelling/sequencing a narrative. We will be focussing on a consistent approach to the use of a capital letter and full stops. We will be looking at using and to join clauses. Lastly, we will be securing knowledge around the difference between a noun and an adjective.

We will continue to develop reading skills and be working on securing our phase 5 phonics.



Maths



This half term we will be continuing with place value 1-75. We will be working on counting in 2's and 10's. In our geometry we will be naming 2D shapes and looking at how we can find $\frac{1}{2}$ and $\frac{1}{4}$ of a shape. We will continue focus on partitioning numbers looking at the whole and part.

Science

This half term we will be focusing on identify animals. We will start by naming part of a animal and then we will move onto classifying the animals. This will include, fish, birds, reptiles, mammals and amphibians. Children will be able to group these animals and say what puts them into each category.



Physical Education

The focus of our PE lessons this half term is:

Humanities

This half term we will be studying Geography. The unit is based on the weather and the types of weather. We will use our map work skills to identify the equator and look at countries that are hot and cold. We will compare the Isle of Wight to Scotland. Finally, we will look at how climate change is changing our landscapes.



Creative Arts

Our Music focus this half term we will be on PITCH.

We will look at how we use our voice and instruments to create different pitches. The topic is all based on superheroes.

We will be competing in an Art day where we will focus on Collage techniques.

Our DT day this term will be on food preparation.



PSHE

During PSHE this term is all focused on rights and respects.

We will look at how we look after people, money and complete a session on basic first aid.
