Dear families,

I cannot believe that we have almost reached half term! It has been a really successful start to the year and I am so impressed with the behavior for learning in the classrooms.

You should have received the list for Autumn 2 after school clubs. Unfortunately homework club was missed off the list! This is a free club on a Monday where a teacher will be there to support children to complete their homework. This is a great opportunity for the children and it means you do not have to focus on this at home. You will need to sign up for this via compass.

In terms of compass and dojo, after half term we will be changing the way we communicate with you. The messaging service via dojo will be turned off and no longer available. To contact teachers, you will now need to send a message via compass. The expectations for teachers to respond remains the same, this will be within school hours and at a time when they are not teaching. If you have an urgent message, this needs to go through the main office.

In order to make lunches more efficient, we will also be asking all parents to pre-book their children's lunches via compass. After half term we will not be taking a lunch register during morning registration so it is vital that parents complete this for everyday your child needs a lunch and that this is completed the night before.

A date for your diaries—we have the school photographer in school on Friday 21st November to take individual and sibling photographs.

Year 5 completed a STEM challenge this week where they had to use their design technology and problem solving skills to make a successful glider. The children loved watching the live national presentation and working together to complete this exciting tasks.

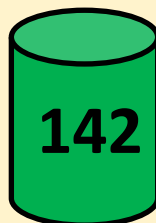
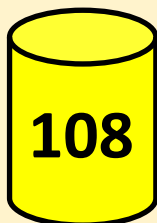
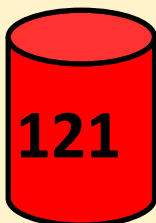
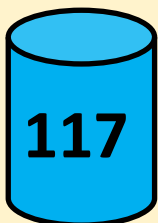
Year 6 enjoyed their visit to the fire station this morning to learn the vital skill of CPR from people who save lives everyday.

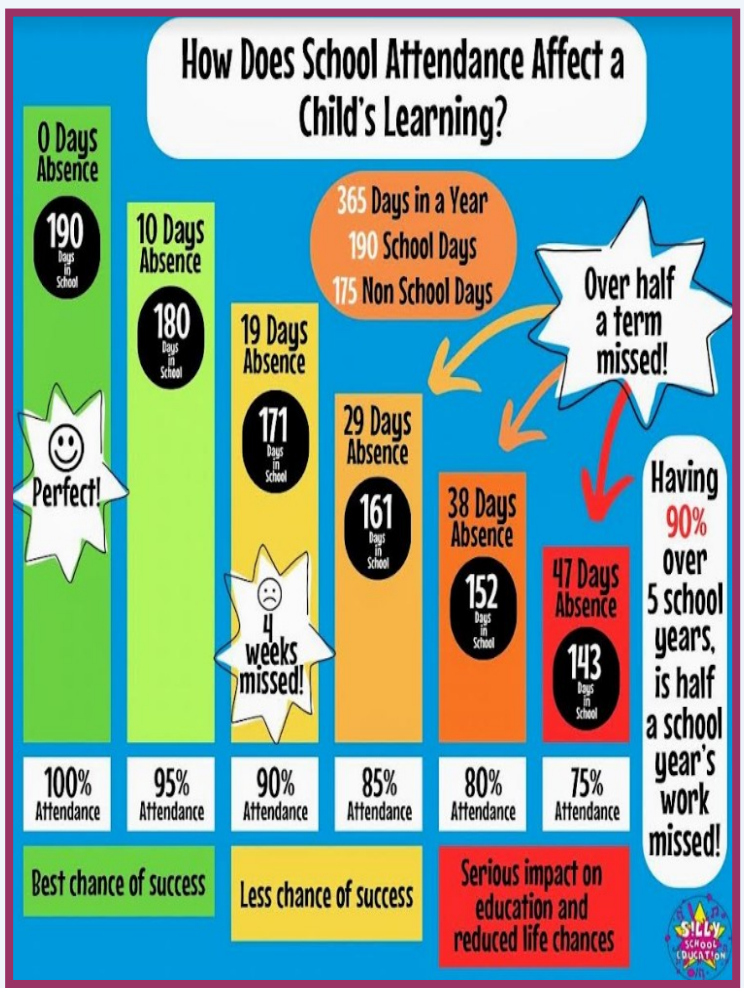

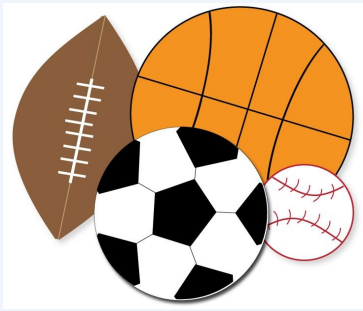

A brilliant team performance from start to finish — well done to everyone!



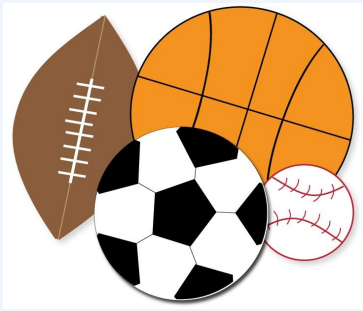
## Tag Rugby Tournament – Year 3/4

## Are you entitled to free school meals?

If you receive any of the following, you can claim free school meals and the school can access additional funding too!

- Income support
- Income based jobseekers allowance
- Income-related employment and support allowance
- Guaranteed pension credit
- Support under part 5 of the immigration and asylum Act 1999
- Universal credit (with an annual net income of no more than £7,400)
- Child tax credit, provided the parent is not entitled to working tax credit and have an annual income, as assessed by HMRC, which does not exceed £16,190.
- Where a parent is entitled to working tax credit run-on (the payment someone receives for a further four weeks after they stop qualifying for working tax credit)

Registering for free school meals could raise an extra £1320 to fund valuable support like extra resources, additional teaching staff or after school activities. This is why it is so important to sign up!

We have forms to complete to make this happen, so please come and fill one in!

## St Mary's Catholic Primary School Uniform

### For all pupils:

Navy polo shirt with logo

Navy round neck sweatshirt

Navy cardigan

(Jumpers and Cardigans may be worn without a logo if wished. However, if you wish to you can purchase them from Kids and Co. with a logo or take the item bought elsewhere to Kids and Co. who for a small fee will add the school logo.)

Warm navy-blue tracksuit bottoms (not shiny or branded ones)

These items may be worn in warm weather but you always need to bring in the tracksuit bottoms so we can access the woods easily

Grey knee length skirt

Grey knee length pinafore

Grey shorts

Blue and white checked dress

White or grey socks / tights

Black shoes – the shoes need to be robust so that when the children are outside at lunch or break time as well as when outside learning their feet are supported. Ballet style shoes or ill-fitting shoes do not provide this support and should not be worn.

The shoes must be plain black with no decoration. They may be trainer styled shoes.

### PE Kit

Navy shorts/skorts

Plain black trainers (Please provide non-laced ones until your child is able to tie their own laces)

Navy tracksuit bottoms

Navy sweatshirt/hoody

### Hair

The children should wear their hair simply. This means no extreme haircuts including sculpting or shaved designs. No colour in hair. Hair bands and clips should be plain and small.

One small pair of earrings may be worn – if the child is not able to take them out they will be covered in tape during PE

**Temporary tattoos, make up, other jewellery, nail varnish and festival bands should not be worn at school.**

Finally, please name all items. If you use pen to name the items, you will know that you need to write the name again several times throughout the year as it does wash out.



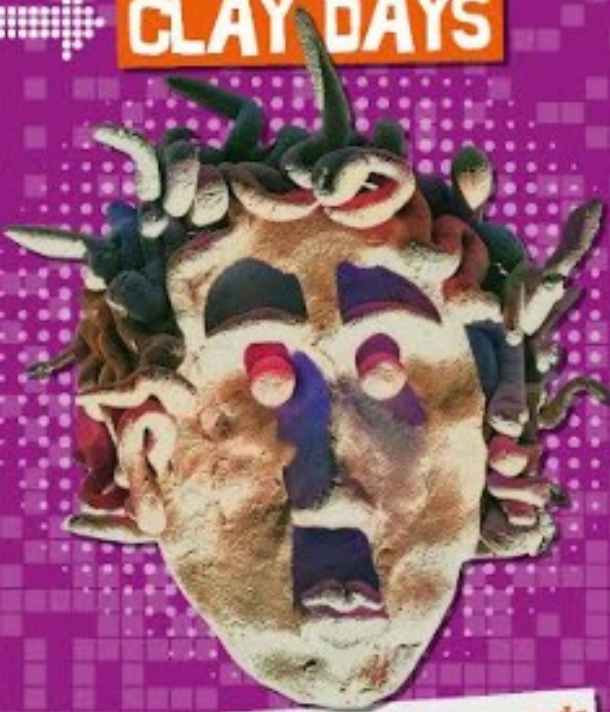

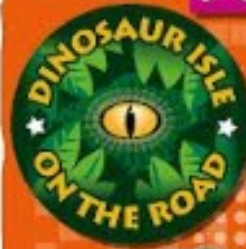
